CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

Eclipse Gymnastics Club is committed to ensuring that those working with children and vulnerable adults will adopt best practice to ensure health, safety and welfare of the participants, coaches and volunteers. The club adheres and follows the British Gymnastics Child Protection Policy.

The club will endeavour to promote the highest standards of care for all members, coaches and officials by: -

- Adopting the British Gymnastics guidelines for the protection of children and vulnerable adults
- Adopting the British Gymnastics health, safety and welfare guidelines
- Appointing a welfare officer to whom grievances or concerns can be made confidentially
- Ensuring that all coaches and officials are suitably trained in child protection and health, safety and welfare issues
- Ensuring that all coaches, volunteers and officials have been screened to confirm their suitability to work with children including all the relevant CRB checks through B.G.
- Ensuring the best coaching guidelines are followed at all times
- Ensuring that all grievances and complaints are dealt with promptly and in accordance with the club's complaints procedure
- Ensuring that at least two responsible adults are present at all training sessions or events
- Ensuring that all participants and their parents are aware of the purpose of videoing, filming or photography during training or events
- Having a zero-tolerance level of poor practice, bullying or any potential form of abuse
